

Adaptations

- Adaptations can be structural or behavioural.
- An organism with **structural adaptations** has **body parts that assist in its survival in its natural habitat.**
- An organism with **behavioural adaptations** **does something that helps in its survival in its natural habitat.**
- Adaptations serve to enhance the survival of organisms by enabling them to
 - ♦ cope with physical factors
 - ♦ obtain food
 - ♦ escape predators
 - ♦ reproduce by finding and mating with their mates
 - ♦ reproduce by dispersal of seeds
