

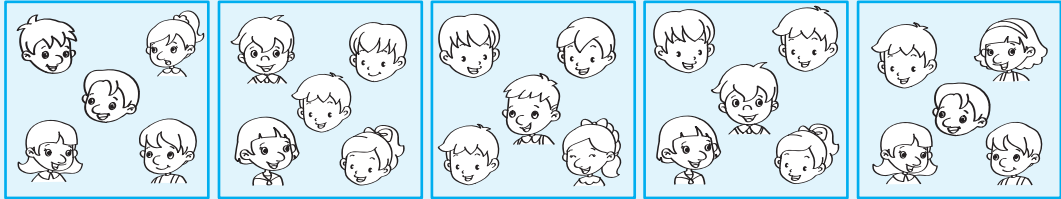

There are 25 children in a class. 5 children form a study group. How many study groups are there?



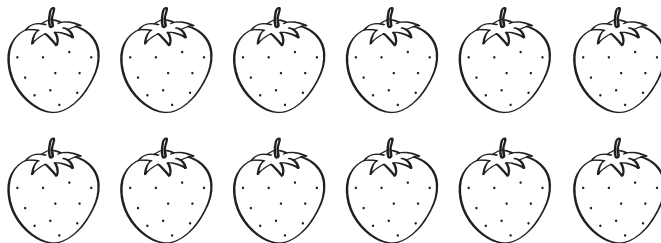
There are 5 study groups.

1. Mrs James buys 20 pencils. She distributes 4 pencils to each of her children. How many children are there?



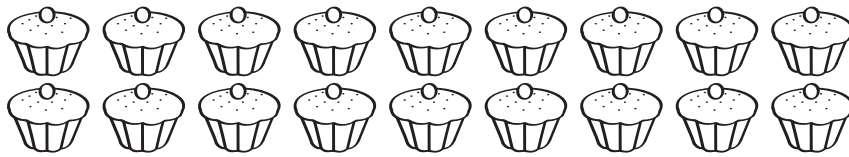

2. 3 boys share 12 strawberries equally. How many strawberries does each boy get?



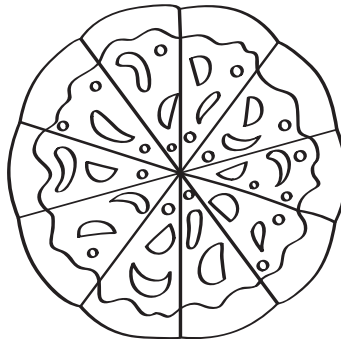
Each boy gets _____ strawberries.

3. Miss Suzy bakes 18 cupcakes. She gives all the cupcakes to 9 students equally. How many cupcakes does each student receive?



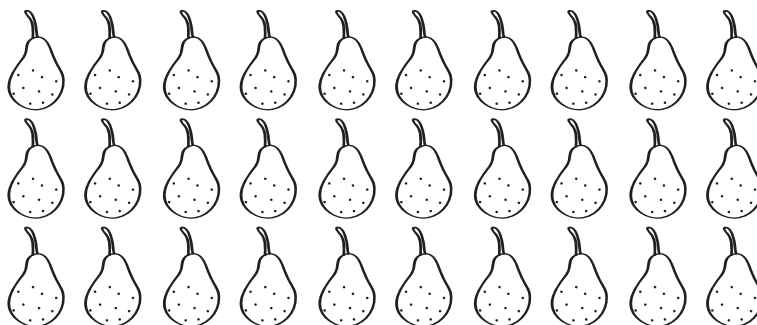
Each student receives _____ cupcakes.

5. A fruiterer has 30 pears. He packs the pears equally into 5 plastic bags. How many pears are there in each plastic bag?



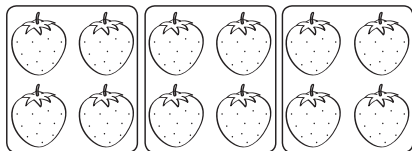

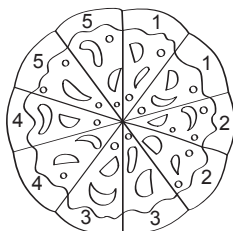
